ABOUT HANSHI BOWLES

BRIEF BIO: Hanshi Robert Bowles is one of the late Grand Master Robert Trias' six Chief instructors.



Hanshi Bowles was the seventeenth (17) inductee into the Trias International Society and Founder/CEO of the International Shuri-Ryu Association. Mr. Bowles has studied martial arts for over 45 years.

In 1972, Hanshi Bowles was a member of the first U.S.K.A. team to tour Europe. Since then he has represented the United States on seven different world tours visiting the following countries: Okinawa, Japan, China, Hong Kong, Thailand, Taiwan, England, Germany, Scotland, France, Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Italy, Panama, and Venezuela.

Hanshi Bowles was the first person in the history of the U.S.K.A. Grand Nationals to win the Triple Crown; 1st place in Kata, Kumite, and Weapons in 1973. With tournament championships spanning over 25 years, he has won the title of U.S.K.A World Champion six times.

In 1994, Mr. Bowles was awarded a 9th degree Black Belt in Shuri Ryu by the late Grand Master Johnny Pachivas. At that time, Mr. Bowles was also officially given the title of "Hanshi" and made the Style Head of Okinawan Shuri Ryu.

In 2006, Hanshi Bowles was awarded a 10th degree Black Belt in Shuri Ryu and presented with the title of "Grand Master".

CURRICULUM

- On The Street: no assailant will be left standing conscious!
- In Competition: your opponent will be looking up from the ground and three points behind!
